

Town Of Pound Ordinance 02009-401 Ordinance to Lower Speed Limit on Town Highways.

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Pound, Marinette County,

The Town Board of the Town of Pound, Marinette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Pound, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting,

provides the authority for the town to reduce the speed limits on certain town highways in

the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective March 15, 2009, speed limits on certain Town of Pound town highways are reduced or modified as follows: reduce the speed limit on North 9th Road from County Road B north to State Highway 64, a distance of three(3) miles, from 55 mph to 45 mph.

B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways, in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on [publication or posting] March 15, 2009.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under ~ 60.80, Wis. stats.
