

**TOWN OF POUND**  
**Snowmobile Route Designation Ordinance**  
**02009-805**  
**EFFECTIVE JANUARY 12, 2010**

**Whereas** Sec. 350.04 (2) of the Wisconsin statutes make provision for Towns to designate highways as snowmobile routes for snowmobile operation. The Town of Pound Board hereby resolves the following:

1. West 10<sup>th</sup> Pound Road, situated between South 23<sup>rd</sup> Road and South 27<sup>th</sup> Road, is hereby designated as a snowmobile route with special speed limitations. Snowmobile operation shall not exceed speeds of 20 miles per hour. Limitation of Sec. 350.04 (2) are in effect as are all other laws governing snowmobiling. This being in effect until April 15, 2010.
2. West 10<sup>th</sup> Pound Road, situated between South 27<sup>th</sup> Road and South 31<sup>st</sup> Road, is hereby designated as a snowmobile route with special speed limitations. Snowmobile operation shall not exceed speeds of 20 miles per hour. Limitation of Sec. 350.04 (2) are in effect as are all other laws governing snowmobiling. This being in effect until April 15, 2010.
3. South 11<sup>th</sup> Road, situated at the intersection of South 11<sup>th</sup> Road and County Road M proceeding South for 100 yards, is hereby designated as a snowmobile route with special speed limitations. Snowmobile operation shall not exceed speeds of 20 miles per hour. Limitation of Sec. 350.04 (2) are in effect as are all other laws governing snowmobiling. This being in effect until April 15, 2010.

**And whereas**, the Kum-A-Long Snowmobile Club agrees to contact all residents, via letter or direct contact, along designated roads to inform them of the snowmobile clubs roll in monitoring usage of designated roads and invite the residents to an informational/education meeting.

Adopted this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2010 by a majority vote of the Town of Pound Board.
